## APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE (Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Kawanhar Doopan, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods as shall be warehoused by or in the Private Warehouse of Messrs: Tobago Inflight Catering Limited—Crown Point, Tobago, Items for the Catering Industry—e.g., Mixed and Dried Fruits, Lettuce, Carrots, Broccoli, Salad Dressing, Veal, Fish, Cheese, Butter, Yogurt, etc., and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.
