DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION TO DEPENDANTS OF DECEASED EMPLOYEE

COMPENSATION in the above matter having been deposited with me under section 8 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, the dependants of the said Samdatt Dass are hereby required to appear before the Commissioner on WEDNESDAY THE 11TH DAY OF JULY, 2001, at 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon at the Court House, Port-of-Spain, when the Commissioner shall proceed to determine the distribution thereof.
