INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES - DECEMBER, 2000

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of December, 2000 was 140.4 showing an increase of 2.6% over the Index for November, 2000.

The All Items Index for January-December, 2000 showed an increase of 3.5% over that for January-December, 1999. This compares with an increase of 3.4% observed in the Index for January-December, 1999 over the similar period in 1998.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section increased from 221.1 in November, 2000 to 237.6 in December, 2000, an increase of 7.5%. Within the Food Section there was an increase of 17.4% in the index for market items. Contributing significantly to this increase were rising prices of chicken, tomatoes, melongene, and irish potatoes.

Price changes in this section accounted for an increase of 3.6 points in the All Items Index.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for December, 2000 indicated that Drink and Tobacco recorded a decrease of 0.4%

Price changes in these sections had no significant effect on the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in December, 2000 compared with those of December, 1999 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:-
