INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES - APRIL, 2001

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of April, 2001 was 140.3 showing an increase of 0.2% over the Index for March, 2001.

The All Items Index for January-April, 2001 showed an increase of 5.5% over that for January-April, 2000. This compares with an increase of 3.1% observed in the Index for January-March, 2000 over the same period in 1999.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section increased by 0.4% from 235.0 in March, 2001 to 235.9 in April, 2001. Within the Food Section there was an increase of 0.6% in the index for market items. Contributing significantly to this increase were rising prices of shrimp, cucumber, carrots, and citrus fruits. These increases in prices were partly offset by a decrease in the prices of chicken, pumpkin, melongene and sweet potatoes.

Price changes in this section accounted for an increase of 0.2 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for April, 2001 compared with March, 2001 indicated that a increases were recorded for Household Supplies and Services, 0.3%; Health and Personal Care, 0.7%; Transportation, 0.2%; and Reading, Recreation and Education, 0.2%. Decreases were recorded for Drink and Tobacco, 0.1%; Clothing and Footwear, 0.2%; and Household Operations, 0.1%.

Price changes in these sections accounted for an increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in April, 2001 compared with those of April, 2000 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:-
