OFFER OF SCHOLARSHIPS BY THE GOVERNMENT OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO FOR THE TRAINING OF CANDIDATES AS METEOROLOGICAL ASSISTANTS

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO invites applications from nationals of Trinidad and Tobago for the award of five (5) scholarships to enable the successful candidates to undergo training for recruitment to the post of Meteorological Assistant I in the Ministry of the Environment.

2. The scholarships are being offered for a four-month period of training at the Caribbean Institute of Meteorology and Hydrology, Barbados, followed by four (4) months of on-the-job training at the Meteorological Services Division, Piarco.

Eligibility

3. Applicants must—

- (a) be citizens of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago;
- (b) be not less than seventeen (17) and not more than twenty-five (25) years of age at the time of applying;
- (c) possess the General Certificate of Education (G.C.E.) or recognised equivalent, e.g., [Caribbean Examination Council (CXC) General Proficiency Grades I and II], with passes in at least five (5) subjects at Ordinary Level, which must include English Language, Mathematics and Physics or Chemistry.

Preparation and Submission of Applications

4. Interested persons are advised that application forms and detailed information concerning the terms of the awards and the prescribed conditions for the submission of applications should be obtained from the following offices:

- (a) Scholarships and Advanced Training Division, Ministry of Human Development, Youth and Culture, ABMA Building, 55-57, St. Vincent Street, Port-of-Spain (8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday);
- (b) Administration Building, Jerningham Street, Scarborough, Tobago; and
- (c) Offices of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Government Diplomatic Missions.

5. Completed applications must reach the Scholarships and Advanced Training Division, Ministry of Human Development, Youth and Culture, preferably brought in by the applicants themselves at the above address, no later than 5th July, 2001.

6. Applicants who are Public Officers must submit their applications through their Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments/Heads of Statutory Authorities, as appropriate.

7. Applications not submitted by the closing date or in accordance with the prescribed conditions will not be considered.
