## AND UPON MATURE CONSIDERATION AND DELIBERATION IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Medical Professionals Association of Trinidad and Tobago, otherwise known as MPATT (hereinafter referred to as "MPATT") whether by its President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Trustees, Officers, Executive Members, servants and/or agents and/or its members or all workers and/or employees and/or other persons who are Medical Practitioners within the meaning of and/or under and by virtue of the provisions of the Medical Board Act Chap.29:50 (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Medical Practitioners") who are employed with the Government/State of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and/or the Ministry of Health of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") and/or Medical Practitioners who are employed and/or who are currently engaged in negotiations for renewal of their contracts of employment with the Government and/or the Regional Health Authorities (as hereinafter defined) or any of them or howsoever otherwise be restrained from taking and/or continuing to take industrial action within the meaning of the Industrial Relations Act Chapter 88:01 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and in particular sections 65 and 67 thereof and the First and Second Schedules thereto in relation to all public hospitals, health centres, laboratories and/or public health care and/or convalescent facilities or other public health facilities (hereinafter referred to as "the public health care facilities") owned and/or operated and/or controlled by the Government and/or the North-West Regional Health Authority

and/or the Central Regional Health Authority and/or the South-West Regional Health Authority and/or the Eastern Regional Health Authority (within the meaning of the Regional Health Authorities Act, 1994 (Act No.5 of 1994) hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Regional Health Authorities")

- (2) MPATT, its President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Trustees, Officers, servants and/or agents and/or its members and/or all Medical Practitioners employed by the Government and/or any and all Medical Practitioners employed and/or all Medical Practitioners who are currently engaged in negotiations for the renewal of their contracts of employment with the Regional Health Authorities and who are engaged in industrial action be and are hereby enjoined from taking and/or continuing to take any such industrial action within the meaning of the provisions of the Act
- (3) All the workers and/or employees and/or Medical Practitioners of the Government and/or the Regional Health Authorities and/or members of MPATT shall not take part in and by this Order are restrained from taking and/or participating howsoever otherwise in any industrial action in accordance with Section 67(2) of the Act
- (4) The Order made herein is without prejudice to the Government's and/or the Regional Health Authorities' rights under Section 63(1)(c) of the Act in relation to all workers and/or employees and/or Medical Practitioners who are at present engaged in industrial action.

AND IT IS ALSO ORDERED that leave be and the same is hereby granted to serve a copy of the said affidavits of EMMANUEL GEORGE and ASHFORD SANKAR both sworn to and lodged herein on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 2003 together with the exhibits thereto together with a copy of this Order on MPATT, with liberty to Party No. 1 to serve such other person or persons as Party No.1 may deem fit

**AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Order be published once in the Trinidad and Tobago Gazette and once in two (2) daily newspapers circulating in Trinidad and Tobago
