TENDERS FOR IMPROVEMENT TO THE GEODETIC INFRASTRUCTURE OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO AGRICULTURE SECTOR REFORM PROGRAMME—LOAN NO. 882/OC-TT

THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank towards the Agriculture Sector Reform Programme. It is intended that the proceeds of this financing will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the "Improvements to the Geodetic Infrastructure of Trinidad and Tobago".

2. The Central Tenders Board now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders from member countries of the Inter-American Development Bank for the Improvements to the Geodetic Infrastructure of Trinidad and Tobago.

3. The interested bidders must show proof of their eligibility, legal status, technical and financial capabilities, and relevant experience for the supply of Global Positioning System (GPS) goods and related services.

- 4. For the award of contract, the order of merit of the qualified bidders will be established on the basis of:
 - (i) The Technical Proposal = pass or fail
 - (ii) The Economic Proposal = 100%

5. A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Central Tenders Board's Office at the address given below on Friday 31st October, 2003 at 10.00 a.m. Bidders who are unable to attend may send written requests for clarifications, which will be dealt with at the pre-bid meeting.

6. Interested bidders may obtain further information, including eligibility to participate and may inspect the bidding documents at the office of the Programme Co-ordinating Unit, Agriculture Sector Reform Programme, at the address given below.

7. A set of bidding documents may be obtained by collection from the Programme Co-ordinator, Agriculture Sector Reform Programme or downloaded from the website www.agriculture.gov.tt.

8. Potential bidders should register their interest with the Programme Co-ordinator of the Agriculture Sector Reform Programme so that they can be notified of any changes to the bidding documents or deadlines.

9. The sealed bids must be submitted in one envelope that contains both the technical information and the economic proposal and clearly marked: "Improvement to the Geodetic Infrastructure of Trinidad and Tobago Agriculture Sector Reform Programme—Loan No. 882/OC—TT".

10. The envelope must be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain, Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, no later than 1.00 p.m. (local time) on Thursday 4th December, 2003.

11. Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter in the presence of the bidders or their representatives, who choose to attend.
