COMPENSATION in the above matter having been deposited with me under section 9 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, the dependants of the said Timkin Mahabir are hereby required to appear before the Commissioner on Monday the 10th day of March, 2003, at 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon at the Court House, Port-of-Spain, when the Commissioner shall proceed to determine the distribution thereof.
