AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF RACING 2000

THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RACING AUTHORITY wishes to advise of the following amendments to the Rules of Racing, 2000:

Rule 31—Disqualification of Horses

Rule 31(1):

Delete (c) and (j); present (d) becomes (c); (e) becomes (d); (f) becomes (e); (g) becomes (f); (h) becomes (g); (i) becomes (h).

 ${\it Rule~32}$ —Entries, Subscriptions, Declarations to run and acceptance for Races: General

32(8) Include new (f) and (g) as follows:

- (f) If his vaccination status is not current.
- (g) If his owner's or any of his part owner's registration has lapsed.

Include: 32(9) New

In the case of 32(8) (f) and (g), any entry/declaration received in breach of these, must be regularised by the Trainer twenty-four (24) hours before post time for the race day in question. Failure by the Trainer to comply, will result in the withdrawal of said horse from the race and a fine imposed on the trainer.

Present (9) becomes (10).

The above Amendments to the Rules of Racing were approved at a meeting of the Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority held on Tuessday 25th February, 2003.
