TENDERS FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN AND DELIVERY OF A DIPLOMA IN EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY UNDER THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SUB-COMPONENT OF THE SECONDARY EDUCATION MODERNIZATION PROGRAMME—IDB LOAN NO. 1180/OC-TT

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) through the Ministry of Education (MOE) has accessed loan funding from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for a Secondary Education Modernization Programme (SEMP) IDB Loan No. 1180/OC–TT, the goal of which is to modernise the education sector in Trinidad and Tobago.

Proposals are invited from International Firms/Accredited Institutions of higher learning to design, develop and deliver a diploma programme in Educational Technology for Secondary School Teachers of Trinidad and Tobago.

The technical proposals shall be evaluated according to the following criteria:

(i) General Background of the University/Institution ... 10 points (ii) Similar work done and prior experience ... 15 points (iii) Qualifications and experience of personnel ... 25 points (iv) Proposed plan of implementation/Execution Schedule (v) Accreditation Status 10 points (vi) Financial Capacity 15 points

The contract will be of interest to a University/Institution with the expertise in the preparation of teachers to teach students at the secondary school level in educational technology.

Institutions wishing to submit proposals may obtain the Terms of Reference and other information from the address (1) below.

The proposals are to be submitted in two (2) sealed envelopes. The first will contain all documentation concerning the professional qualifications of the personnel who are to be involved in the programme, evidence of having conducted similar programmes in developing countries, references, proposed methodology for carrying out the activities as outlined in the Terms of Reference, work schedule and proposed schedule of deliverables.

The second envelope will contain an itemized budget of the cost of the services offered.

Each University/Institution must submit one (1) original and six (6) copies each of the technical and financial proposal in separately sealed envelopes to the address (2) below not later than 1.00 p.m. (local time) on Thursday 31st July, 2003.

Each envelope must be clearly marked: "Consultancy Services for the design and delivery of a Diploma in Educational Technology under the professional development sub-component of the Secondary Education Modernization Programme—IDB Loan No. 1180/OC-TT".
