### APPOINTMENT OF A CUSTOMS AREA

*(Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Earl Clement, Acting Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 2 of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Customs Area for the storage of machinery, equipment, raw materials, semi-manufactured goods and other ingredients imported or taken out of bond by Heat 'N' Eat Ltd., at 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Mile Mark, Tumpuma Road, San Raphael, Arima, for the manufacture of value added pouched poultry products: chicken and turkey nuggets, burgers, ham, bacon and franks; smoked chicken and turkey breasts, popcorn chicken, buffalo wings, breaded and smoked chicken breasts, chicken breast patties, spicy and honey barbeque wings, rotisserie chicken or such other products as may subsequently be approved.

#### SCHEDULE

A room measuring 3.65 metres by 6.09 metres, a total area of 22.23 square metres, enclosed in a building situate on the eastern side of the compound of the WGM Group of Companies, at 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Mile Mark along Tumpuma Road, San Raphael, Arima.

The building is constructed of concrete blocks and steel beams and is covered with galvanised sheets, with a steel gate on the western side.

The area is bounded on the north by Tumpuna Road, on the west by an access road, and on the east and the south by the Guanapo River.
