NOTICE OF VACANCY OF TEMPORARY OFFICE OF STATE COUNSEL III IN THE MINISTRY OF NATIONAL SECURITY

Minimum Requirements

Considerable (4 to 8 years) experience in professional legal work, including experience in advocacy such as may have been gained in the lower classes or in private practice, and training as evidenced by the possession of a legal education certificate from an accredited institution.

Necessary Special Requirement

Evidence of having been admitted to practise as an Attorney-at-law in Trinidad and Tobago.

Kind of Work

1. Receives requests from Heads of Units in the General Administration and Heads of Departments in the Ministry for advice on their legal problems; makes the necessary investigations and gives legal advice or opinion.
2. Advises on the application of the disciplinary regulations/the institution of disciplinary proceedings or otherwise against public officers and acts as Defence Counsel at Disciplinary Tribunal proceedings.
3. Examines/prepares draft Regulations of terms and conditions of employment of members of the Protective Services and attends Legislative Review Committee meetings on matters pertaining to the Ministry of National Security.
4. Advises on issues which may arise between the Ministry of National Security and the respective Associations Representative of public officers, daily-rated workers and members of the Protective Services.
5. Advises the Minister of National Security on any legal issues relating to any of the Agencies within the Ministry and on his Parliamentary Agenda.
6. Attends Parliament when issues pertaining to National Security are debated.
7. Negotiates Mutual Legal Assistance Treaties and conducts extensive research into the laws of other countries regarding legislation governing mutual legal assistance. Develops a legal framework with respect to co-operation with foreign agencies at the international level—bilateral, multilateral treaties.
8. Advises on and assists in the implementation of treaty responsibilities.
9. Examines and/or prepares Cabinet Notes that relate to the Laws of Trinidad and Tobago as these affect the Ministry of National Security.
