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APPOINTMENT OF A COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY

THE PUBLIC is hereby notified that the President has appointed a Commission under the Commission of Enquiry Act, Chap. 19:01 with the following terms and reference:

1. To enquire into—

The allegation of the removal of materials, equipment and resources from the site of the Scarborough Hospital to the site of a private construction project called “Land Date” at Mason Hall, Tobago, with particular reference to the following issues:

- (i) whether the materials, equipment and resources were in fact removed in the circumstances as alleged;
- (ii) if materials, equipment and resources were in fact removed as alleged, whether there was any impropriety on the part of any Minister.

2. To enquire into the circumstances surrounding the procurement processes and the award of all contracts made to NH International and Warner Construction Limited from 2002 to the present, with particular reference to—

- (i) whether the awards of those contracts were made in accordance with the law and the established practices and procedures governing the award of public contracts;
- (ii) whether there was any impropriety on the part of any person or authority in relation to the procurement process or the award of any contract to NH International or Warner Construction Limited;

3. To make such observations and recommendations arising out of its deliberations as the Commission may deem appropriate so that the integrity of terms and reference are effectively fulfilled.

- (i) The Commission of Enquiry calls for written submission from the public or any interested corporate body, Association or Organization, on any or all of the above matters.
