PROPOSALS FROM INTERNATIONAL CONSULTING FIRMS TO DESIGN AND CONDUCT AN ENVIRONMENTAL, SURFACE AND STRUCTURAL RISK ASSESSMENT OF THE BICHE HIGH SCHOOL (BHS) AND ITS IMMEDIATE ENVIRONS, MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO, through its Ministry of Education, has implemented a comprehensive reform and modernization initiative geared towards accelerating the development of the Secondary Education System. The benefits are expected to continue accruing in the forms of improvements in the quality of the curricula and learning, a more diversified skills market and enhancements in the structural and administrative frameworks of the Ministry and the schools.

The Programme caters for the construction of several new secondary schools at strategic catchment locations. The first and second phases of construction have been completed and all but one of the schools have become operational. The one exception is the Biche High School (BHS), the completion of which has been postponed owing to serious concerns as to the safety and stability of the building and its environs.

It is against this background, that the Government of Trinidad and Tobago is desirous of recruiting the services of an International Firm of Consultants to conduct an environmental, surface and structural risk assessment of the BHS and its environs.

Accordingly, proposals are invited from qualified international firms for the provision of consulting services for the conduct of an environmental, surface and structural risk assessment of the BHS and its immediate environs.
