REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN OCCUPATIONAL PENSION PLAN FOR THE PUBLIC SERVICE, MINISTRY OF FINANCE

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (GORTT) is desirous of acquiring the services of an Actuarial Firm to develop a modern occupational pension plan for the Public Service and to provide actuarial services and advice to the Working Group on Pension Reform in Trinidad and Tobago. The Central Tenders Board, on behalf of the Ministry of Finance, is requesting proposals for the development of a Modern Occupational Pension Plan for the Public Service.

Prospective consulting firms will be required to attend a pre-bid meeting at the Project Unit, Ministry of Finance, Level 2, Maritime Centre, Barataria, Trinidad at 10.00 a.m., on Friday 9th June, 2006.

Local proposals must be accompanied by valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue, and a Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the following criteria with weighting as shown:

- (i) Experience relating to similar assignments (20 points)
- (ii) Qualifications and experience of key staff for the assignment (30 points)
- (iii) Adequacy of the proposed work plan and methodology in response to the TOR (40 points)
- (iv) Local participation of key staff (10 points).

Firms will be required to achieve a minimum score of 75 points to be considered.

One (1) original and five (5) copies of your technical and financial proposals should be placed in two (2) separately sealed envelopes clearly marked: "Proposal for the Development of a Modern Occupational Pension Plan for the Public Service". Envelopes must be addressed to: Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain, Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office on or before 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 29th, June, 2006.

Firms should note that proposals should be packaged to fit the slot of the Tenders Box, which is 37.5 cm. x 5.5 cm.

Technical proposals will be opened shortly thereafter. A representative from the firm may attend the opening.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying the cost incurred by any firm submitting a proposal.
