# GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO UPDATED PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE NATIONAL LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SYSTEM AUTHORITY (NALIS)

## IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTIONS 7, 8 AND 9 OF THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA) 1999

## THE POLLOWING INFORMATION IS PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SYSTEM AUTHORITY (NALIS)

In accordance with Sections 7, 8, and 9 of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 1999, the National Library and information System Authority (NALIS) is required by law to publish the following statement, which is an update of the statement bublished in January 2008. This statement lists the documents and information generally swallshie to the public.

The Act gives the public a general right of access to official documents held by the National Library and information System Authority (NALIS), namely:

- A legal right for each person to access information held by NAUS;
- A legal right for each person to have official information relating to him/herself amended where it is incomplete, incorrect or misleading;
- A legal right to obtain reasons for adverse decisions made regarding an applicant's request for information under the FOIA;
- A legal right to complain to the Cmb. daman and to soply to the High Court for Judicial Review to challenge adversed decisions made under the FOIA.

Function and Structure of NALIS

## Nission Statement:

## The Mission of NALIS is: -

To provide an international standard of service that delivers equitable access to information in all formats through highly capable and motivated staff, or lising state of the art technologies and facilities to support the developmental and recreations needs of Trinidad and Tobago.

The National Library and Information System Authority is a Statutory Board, established by Act. No. 18 of 1998, which provides for "the development and coordination of all library and information services in Trinidad and Tobago and related matters."

This Act incorporates the then existing three Public Library Services into the Authority, it also created the mechanism for bringing special libraries, floraries in the educational sector and build libraries in Tobago under the ambit of the Authority. This is done through Memoranda of Understanding with Permanent Secretaries. Heads of Department, Heads of Statutory Authorities and the appropriate officer of the Tobago House of Assembly, regarding the management of libraries under their control. (Cl. 6 (1) Act No. 18 of 1989).

Section 9 (1) of this Act provides for the establishment of a Board, the principal cuty of which is to ensure the proper and efficient performance

of the functions of NALIS. This Board comprises nine (9) persons drawn from various cisc pines and includes the Executive Director who is an excerticip member.

The administration of NALIS is headed by an Executive Director and Deputy Executive Director, who are appointed by the President, in accordance with Sections 12 and 17 of the Act respectively.

The overall staffing of all libraries within NALIS totals about 600 persons. The <u>Head Office</u> of the Authority is located at the National Library of Trinicad and Topage, Corner Hart and Abercromby Streets. Port-of-Spain, NALIS comprises a even (11) Divisions and Departments which are headed by Directors or professional Heads of Departments.

These Divisions and Departments and an overview of their functions are as follows:

- Office of the Executive Director -The Executive Director is charged with managing "the effects of NALIS subject to the directions of and in accordance with policies determined by the Board."
- 2. The Public Libraries Division is responsible for administering and coordinating the network of Public Libraries and Mobile Libraries serving crizens throughout Trinkfard. Libraries are located in Port-of-Spain, St. James, Diego Martin, San Juan, Tunapuna, Maloney, Arima Sangre Grance, St. Helena Mayaro, San Fernanco, Couva Chaguanas, Princes Town, Woruga, La Brea, Point Fortin. Siceria, Cedros and Dece. Forty-One (41) mobile ibrary stops are distributed in North, East Certral and South Trinkfard, as well as 8 bookdrops to preschools in the North Region.
- 3. Her Hage Library Division is responsible for acquiring, preserving and tacilitating access to all material pertinent to Trinidad and Tobago and the Cariobean. The Heritage Library is located on the Second Floor of the National Library of Trinidad and Tobago Port-of-Spain, and is freely accessible to members of the public for the conduct of research and reference in Trinidad and Tobago and Cariobean subject areas.
- The Educational Library Services Division is responsible for staff in libraries in the education sector.

- The Information Networks Division is responsible to: -(i) provision of technology for on-line information access throughout the florary services.
