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## TENDER FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS FOR THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT BRANCH MINISTRY OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT

TENDERS are invited for the Maintenance of Traffic Control Signals for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport for a period of one (1) year (2007/2008).

Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain.

Any further technical information may be obtained during normal working hours from Mr. Dexter Wong Wai, Acting Chief Traffic Engineer, Traffic Management Branch, Level 2, Ministry of Works and Transport, Corner Richmond and London Streets, Port-of-Spain, at Telephone Number 625-1225, Extension 2312.

A pre-tender meeting will be held at 10.00 a.m. on Level 2, Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport, Corner Richmond and London Streets, Port-of-Spain on Thursday 12th April, 2007.

Separate contracts may be awarded for each region or a combination of regions.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (a) valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender;
- (b) a valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original and three (3) copies of the tenders must be placed in sealed envelopes, addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and clearly marked on the outside: "Tender for the Maintenance of Traffic Control Signals for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport", and must be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office at the above address not later than 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 19th April, 2007.

It should be noted that the slot in the Tenders Box is 37.5 cm x 5.5 cm. Tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.
