8. Exercises jurisdiction in family matters, affecting the custody and maintenance of children, matters of domestic violence and juveniles brought before the Court.
9. Adjudicates in ejectment proceedings (Landlord/Tenant disputes).
10. Serves on tribunals as required, e.g., Mental Health, Agricultural, etc.
11. Prepares and submits to the Court of Appeal, written reasons for decisions that are the subject to appeal.
12. Manages the proceedings in Court.
