# Act No. 10 of 2010

[L.S.]

AN ACT to amend the Land Tenants (Security of Tenure) Act, Chap. 59:54

[Assented to 30th November, 2010]

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 13(1) of the Preamble Constitution that an Act of Parliament to which that section applies may expressly declare that it shall have effect even though inconsistent with sections 4 and 5 of the Constitution and if any Act does so declare, it shall have effect accordingly; Constitution that an Act of Parliament to which that section applies is one the Bill for which has been passed by both Houses of Parliament and at the final vote thereon in each House has been supported by the votes of not less than three-fifths of all the members of that House:

And whereas it is necessary and expedient that the provisions of this Act shall have effect even though inconsistent with sections 4 and 5 of the Constitution:

ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad Enactment and Tobago as follows:

### 1. This Act may be cited as the Land Tenants Short title (Security of Tenure) (Amendment) Act, 2010.

#### 2. This Act shall have effect even though inconsistent Act inconsistent with Constitution with sections 4 and 5 of the Constitution.

**3.** Section 4(3) of the Land Tenants (Security of Section 4 of <sup>Chap. 59:54 amended</sup> Tenure) Act is amended by deleting the words "at least six months" and substituting the words "on or".
