Made by the Commissioner of Police under Section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (SMALL AND MEDIUM BANDS PRELIMINARY) ORDER, 2010

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary _{Citation} Provisions) (Small and Medium Bands Preliminary) Order, 2010.

2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 11.00 a.m. on Duration Sunday 24th January, 2010 and 1.00 a.m. on Monday 25th January, 2010.

- 3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following: Parking and vehicular
 - (a) St. Vincent Street, between Independence Square South traffic and South Quay; and prohibited
 - (b) South Quay, between St. Vincent Street and Broadway.

4. Parking is prohibited on Broadway, between Beetham Highway Parking and Independence Square South.

5. Taxis shall operate as follows:

 (a) Long Circular/Wrightson Road taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and Chacon Street, facing east;

- (b) Diego Martin/Petit Valley taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the northern side of Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and Chacon Street, facing east;
- (c) San Fernando taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the northern side of Independence Square South, between Broadway and Henry Street, facing west; and
- (d) Chaguanas taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square South, between Broadway and Henry Street, facing west.

6. Small and Medium bands shall assemble on St. Vincent Street, Band route between Independence Square South and South Quay, then proceed

east along South Quay to be judged at the Down Town Stand and on completion of their performance, bands shall disassemble on Broadway.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
