MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(PARLIAMENTARY GENERAL ELECTIONS MEETINGS)  
ORDER, 2010

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary <sup>Citation</sup> Provisions) (Parliamentary General Elections Meetings) Order, 2010.
2. This Order has effect from 10.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. on Saturday <sup>Duration</sup> 22nd May, 2010.
3. Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. traffic restriction <sup>Traffic route</sup> for unauthorized vehicles using the Priority Bus Route would be relaxed.
4. Parking is prohibited along the southern side of the Priority Bus <sup>Parking prohibited</sup> Route.
5. (1) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on <sup>One-way traffic</sup> Saturday 22nd May, 2010, vehicular traffic shall proceed on—
  - (a) El Socorro Road, between Fifth Street and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway in a southerly direction only; and
  - (b) Aranguez Road, between the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and Coronation Street in a northerly direction only.
- (2) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Saturday 22nd May, 2010, vehicular traffic using the Orange Grove-Trincity Road, between the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and the Priority Bus Route shall proceed in a southerly direction only.

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
