Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

## THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (ST. JAMES COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE OF STEELBANDS) ORDER, 2010

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (St. James Community Improvement Committee of Steelbands) Order, 2010.
- 2. This Order has effect between the hours of 6.00 p.m. on Duration Saturday 12th June, 2010 and 3.00 a.m. on Sunday 13th June, 2010.
- 3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on Western Main Parking and vehicular Road, between Roxy Roundabout and George Cabral Street. traffic prohibited
- 4. (1) West bound traffic along Western Main Road shall be Alternative diverted south onto Damian Street and onto Mucurapo Road.
- (2) East bound traffic along Western Main Road shall be diverted north onto George Cabral Street, east onto Kathleen Street, then onto Dehli Street and onto Barbados Road.
  - 5. Parking is prohibited on—
    - (a) Damian Street;
    - (b) George Cabral Street;
    - (c) Kathleen Street; and
    - (d) Delhi Street.
  - 6. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

Vehicular

Parking prohibited

- (a) Salazar Street, Jerry Street, Bournes Road, Brunton Street, prohibited Mooneram Street and Bombay Street from Church Street in a southerly direction;
- (b) Calcutta Street, Madras Street, Agra Street and Bengal Street from Delhi Street in a southerly direction;
- (c) Luckput Street, Mathura Street, Romeo Street and Lazarrie Street from Carlton Avenue in a southerly direction;

- (d) Ethel Street from Bay Road in a northerly direction;
- (e) Dengue Street, Vidale Street, Clarence Street and Nizam Street from Anderson Street in a northerly direction; and
- (f) Nepaul Street, Cawnpore Street, Benares Street and Lucknow Street from Hyderbad Street in a northerly direction.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
