### ORDER

Made by the President under section 10 of the FISCAL INCENTIVES ACT

# THE FISCAL INCENTIVES (DAIRY DISTRIBUTORS LIMITED) ORDER, 2010

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Fiscal Incentives (Dairy Citation Distributors Limited) Order, 2010.
  - 2. In this Order, "the Act" means the Fiscal Incentives Act.

Interpretation Chap. 85:01

- 3. Liquid milk, milk drinks and juices are declared to be approved Declaration of approved products. products
- 4. Dairy Distributors Limited, a company incorporated in Trinidad Declaration of and Tobago (hereafter called "the Company"), is declared an approved approved enterprise in respect of liquid milk, milk drinks and juices (hereafter referred to as "the approved products"), to be manufactured at Zone 9, Millennium Park, Trincity, with effect from the 1st day of September, 2012 (hereafter referred to as "the production day").
- 5. The Company, classified as a highly capital intensive enterprise Classification under section 9 of the Act, is granted for a period of ten years and benefits commencing from the production day, exemption from Value Added Tax in accordance with the provisions of section 44(g) of the Value Added Tax Act. Chap. 75:06
  - 6. The Company shall—

Obligations

- (a) undertake locally or cause to be undertaken locally, the approved minimum manufacturing processes set out in the Schedule; enterprise
- (b) maintain to the satisfaction of the Board of Inland Revenue, accounts in respect of its business, and the accounts so maintained shall allow for the transactions relating to the manufacture of the approved products to be clearly identifiable from the transactions relating to the business of the Company;
- (c) submit annually, notwithstanding the relief from the tax under this Order, a return of the income so exempt from tax, at the same time and in the same manner as would have been required had income not been so exempted;

- (d) observe the practice and policy prevailing in Trinidad and Tobago as regards labour relations and conditions of employment;
- (e) comply with the environmental codes of conduct for the industry in respect of the requirements of the Environmental Management Authority;
- (f) submit to the Ministry of Trade and Industry any information requested in the manner directed and at such times as the Ministry may request; and
- (g) obtain all statutory approvals from the Town and Country Planning Division, Ministry of Planning, Economic and Social Restructuring and Gender Affairs.

### **SCHEDULE**

[Paragraph 6(a)]

### MINIMUM MANUFACTURING PROCESS

- (1) Liquid milk and milk drinks are reconstituted by mixing milk powder and warm water with a high speed mixer in a sterile container. After reconstitution, the products are heated at one hundred and forty degrees Celsius for four seconds. The products are then aseptically transferred to the filling machine which fills the products, under sterile conditions, in pre-sterilized packaging material.
- (2) After the juices are reconstituted the liquid juices are heated at ninety-five degrees Celsius for ten to fifteen seconds. The juices are then aseptically transferred to the filling machine which fills the product, under sterile conditions, in pre-sterilized packaging material.
