REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE  
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF  
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (MAXI-  
TAXI STAND/MAXI-TAXI STOP) (CUREPE/SAN JUAN)  
REGULATIONS, 2010

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control<sup>Citation</sup> (Experimental Scheme) (Maxi-Taxi Stand/Maxi-Taxi Stop) (Curepe/San Juan) Regulations, 2010.
2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday 25th October,<sup>Duration</sup> 2010 to Sunday 23rd January, 2011.
3. In these Regulations, “maxi-taxi” means a public service vehicle<sup>Interpretation</sup> with seating accommodation for not less than nine nor more than twenty-five passengers so authorized by the Minister to operate on the Priority Bus Route.
4. A maximum of ten maxi-taxis operating the westbound route<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup> shall park facing west on the southern side of the Priority Bus Route,<sup>stand</sup> nine metres west of Southern Main Road.
5. A maxi-taxi stop for westbound maxi-taxis operating the<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup> westbound route shall be marked on the southern side of the Priority<sup>stop</sup> Bus Route nine metres east of Southern Main Road.
6. A maximum of eight maxi-taxis operating the eastbound route<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup> shall park facing east on the northern side of the Priority Bus Route<sup>stand</sup> nine metres west of Saddle Road.
7. A maxi-taxi stop for eastbound maxi-taxis operating the<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup> eastbound route shall be marked on the northern side of the Priority<sup>stop</sup> Bus Route ten metres west of Saddle Road.
8. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these<sup>Offence and</sup> Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence to a fine<sup>penalty</sup> of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and  
impounding  
of vehicles

9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
