## THE COMMON EXTERNAL TARIFF (SUSPENSION) (NO. 5) ORDER, 2010

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Common External Tariff Citation (Suspension) (No. 5) Order, 2010.
- 2. In this Order, where "Ex" is used in relation to an item number Interpretation under a heading listed in the First Column of the First Schedule, that item number shall refer only to the corresponding goods described in the Second Column.
