INTENTION TO MAKE A NOTICE DESIGNATING THE GOLDEN TREE FROG AND OCELOT AS ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE SPECIES

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority"), in exercise of the power granted to it by section 41 of the Environmental Management Act, Chap. 35:05 ("the Act") proposes to make Notices designating the Golden Tree Frog and Ocelot as Environmentally Sensitive Species ("the Proposed Notices").
