Act No. 1 of 2011

An Act to supplement and vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of which was authorized by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2010) Act, 2009

[Assented to 21st January, 2011]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) (Financial Year 2010) Act, 2011

Further issue of \$1,184,904,001 from the Consolidated Fund 2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of one thousand, one hundred and eighty four million, nine hundred and four thousand, and one dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending 30th September, 2010 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.

Schedule

Increase in Heads of Expenditure Act. No. 9 of 2009 **3.** The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2010) Act, 2009 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Reduction in Heads of Expenditure 4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2010) Act, 2009 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Sums appropriated in respect of Heads specified in Part II may be utilized Chap. 69:01 5. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2010) Act, 2009 and not utilized at the commencement of this Act may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
