THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the project, Support for a Seamless Education System Programme (SES) (LO 2138/OC-TT). This is in keeping with the Government's official policy for development of the Education System and the nation's children through its transformation initiative.

Integral to the success of this Programme and the transformation initiative, is the MOE's pursuit of the twin goals of inclusiveness and universal access to a quality education. A major initiative in this regard has been the embracing, supported by the instituting of measures geared at treating and improving the well-being and opportunities of and for all children, including both the challenged and the gifted. The MOE has decided on the recruitment of the services of a firm with the requisite specialist expertise to advance the pursuit of these goals and is initiating the procurement process with the help of the Central Tenders Board (CTB).

Accordingly, on behalf of the Ministry of Education, the Central Tenders Board (CTB) invites eligible consulting firms/institutions to indicate their interest in providing, an overall strategy and implementation plan for the achievement of universal early childhood care and education (ECCE).
