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TENDER FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SKYLIGHT ROOF AND STEEL ROOF FOR THE CITY HALL
PORT-OF-SPAIN CORPORATION, MINISTRY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT

TENDERS are invited for the construction works for the Port-of-Spain Corporation, Ministry of Local Government under the Development Programme 2010–2011 as follows:

Project 1—Construction of a Skylight Roof—City Hall.

Project 2—Construction of a Steel Roof—City Hall.

Tender documents can be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain. Telephone Number 625-4330.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each package to the Director of Contracts, Central Tenders Board and attach the original receipt to the tender. This deposit will be received by cash or certified cheque from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m.

Any further technical information may be obtained during normal working hours from Mr. Chanka David, Acting City Engineer, Port-of-Spain City Corporation at Telephone Numbers 623-6926 or 340-0554.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held for prospective tenderers on Monday 8th August, 2011 at 10.00 a.m. at the Port-of-Spain Corporation, Ministry of Local Government.

Separate contracts may be awarded for each project.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (a) valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender;
- (b) a valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original Tender and two (2) copies each of the Form of Tender and Bill of Quantities, for each project must be placed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and clearly marked on the outside: "Project 1—Construction of a Skylight Roof—City Hall for the Port-of-Spain City Corporation, Ministry of Local Government" or "Project 2—Construction of a Steel Roof—City Hall for the Port-of-Spain City Corporation, Ministry of Local Government".

Envelopes must be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box, located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 18th August, 2011.

Tenderers are asked to note that the dimensions of the slot on the Tenders Box are 37.5 cm x 5.5 cm and tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
