APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE  
(*Customs Act, Chap. 78:01*)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the provisions of the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Fitzroy A. John, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export of the following goods, as shall be warehoused by or in the Private Warehouse of Messrs. Maruni Enterprises Limited *viz*: Steel Plates, Sheets, Angles, Beams, Sections, Hoists, Channels, Flats, Expanded Metal, Hardware Items, Plywood, Galvanized Steel Gratings, Corrugated Galvanize, Galvanized Sheets and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.

SCHEDULE

An area comprising two (2) sections. The first section consists of an area measuring 1,033.45 square metres, constructed from structural H Beams and covered with a roof of corrugated galvanized sheets. The second section is annexed to the eastern side of the first and comprises an uncovered area of 418.714 square metres.

The total length of the two (2) sections measures from the eastern side 34.34 metres north to south, 63.55 metres east to west, 10.52 metres south to north and 63.55 metres west to east.

The warehouse is situated on lands of Gopaul Lands Hardware, Marabella House, Marabella Roundabout, Marabella, in the Ward of Victoria. The warehouse is bounded on the north by the two (2) lumber sheds owned by Gopaul Lands Hardware Limited, buildings tenanted by P.V.F. Limited and Hi Lo Foods Stores and a Hardware owned by Gopaul Lands Hardware abutted by Union Park West Road. It is bounded on the south by lands of Maruni Enterprises Limited, on the east by lands of Maruni Enterprises Limited abutted by Ruby Lane and on the west by lands of Maruni Enterprises Limited abutted by San Fernando Bye-Pass Road.
