INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—June, 2010 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of June, 2010 was 179.2 representing an increase of 6.3 points or 3.6% above the Index for May, 2010.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January–June, 2010 over that for the period January–June, 2009 was 7.4%. This reflects a reduction when compared with a rate of inflation of 10.8% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January–June, 2009 over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2008

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 365.4 in May, 2010 to 400.6 in June, 2010, reflecting an increase of 9.6%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of whole chicken, powdered whole cream milk, tomatoes, cucumber, christophene, watercress, yams, sweet potatoes, dasheen, ochroes, limes, celery, and canned vegetables. However, the full impact of these price increases was dampened by a general decline in the prices of fish—cavalli and carite, shrimp, irish potatoes, melongene, carrots, oranges, ripe bananas, melon and grapes.

Price changes in this section, for the month of June, 2010 accounted for a net overall increase of 6.3 points in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for June, 2010 compared with May, 2010 reflected an increase in the sub-index for Health 0.3%. However, the sub-index for Clothing and Footwear declined by 0.5%.

Price changes in these sections for the month of June, 2010 had a negligible net overall effect on the All Items Index.

Changes in consumer prices in June, 2010 compared with those of June, 2009 reflected in various sections of the Index are shown hereunder:
