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TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF SIX KILOMETRES OF A 3-CABLE HIGH TENSION BARRIER SYSTEM FOR THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT BRANCH, HIGHWAYS DIVISION, MINISTRY OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT

TENDERS are invited for the supply, delivery and installation of six (6) kilometres of a 3-cable High Tension Barrier System for the Traffic Management Branch, Highways Division, Ministry of Works and Transport.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held for prospective tenderers on Friday January 21st, 2011 at 9.30 a.m. at the office of Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport, Mon Repos Roundabout, San Fernando.

Tenders must be accompanied by valid—

- (a) Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender;
- (b) Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Only original certificates would be accepted.

The original and three (3) copies of the Tender must be placed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and clearly marked on the outside: "Tender for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of six (6) kilometres of 3-cable High Tension Barrier System for the Ministry of Works and Transport".

Envelopes must be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office, not later than 1.00 p.m. (local time) on Thursday 3rd February, 2011.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or a representative may be present at the opening.
