THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the project, Support for a Seamless Education System Programme (SES) (LO 2138/OC-TT). This is in keeping with the Government's official policy for development of the Education System and the nation's children through its transformation initiative.
