## REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Transport under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

## THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (PORT-OF-SPAIN) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2011

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (Port-of-Spain) (No. 2) Regulations, 2011.
- 2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday 13th June, Duration 2011 to Monday 12th September, 2011.
- 3. Motorists shall proceed in both directions on Queen Street, Two-way between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street.
  - 4. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking

- (a) Hart Street, from St. Vincent Street to a point thirty prohibited metres eastwards;
- (b) Charlotte Street, between Park Street and Independence Square North;
- (c) Queen Street, between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (d) Edward Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
- (e) the eastern side of Edward Street, between Queen Street and Sackville Street on Monday, Wednesday and Friday except public holidays;
- (f) the western side of Edward Street, between Queen Street and Sackville Street on Tuesday and Thursday except public holidays;
- (g) on Richmond Street, between London Street and Independence Square North;
- (h) the northern side of Queen Street, between George Street and Chacon Street from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday except public holidays;

- (i) the southern side of Queen Street, between George Street and Chacon Street from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday and Friday except public holidays;
- (j) the northern side of Prince Street, between George Street and Henry Street from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday except public holidays;
- (k) the southern side of Prince Street, between George Street and Henry Street from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday and Friday except public holidays;
- (1) the eastern side of George Street, between Prince Street and Independence Square North from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Tuesday and Thursday except public holidays;
- (m) the western side of George Street, between Prince Street and Independence Square North from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday and Friday except public holidays;
- (n) the eastern side of George Street, between Duke Street and Prince Street on Tuesday and Thursday except public holidays;
- (o) the western side of George Street, between Duke Street and Prince Street on Monday, Wednesday and Friday except public holidays;
- (p) the western side of Henry Street, between Park Street and Independence Square North on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday except public holidays;
- (q) the eastern side of Henry Street, between Park Street and Independence Square North on Monday, Wednesday and Friday except public holidays;
- (r) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street;
- (s) the northern side of Albion Street, between Dundonald Street and Chancery Lane;
- (t) the southern side of Park Street, from Victoria Square West to Victoria Square East;
- (u) the eastern side of Frederick Street, between Park Street and Independence Square North from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday and Friday except public holidays; and
- (v) the western side of Frederick Street, between Park Street and Independence Square North from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday except public holidays.

## 5. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in—

One-way traffic

- (a) a northerly direction on Stone Street, between Charles Street to Flament Street;
- (b) an easterly direction on Flament Street, between Stone Street and Scott Street;
- (c) a southerly direction on Scott Street, between Flament Street to Charles Street; and
- (d) a westerly direction on Charles Street, between Scott Street and Stone Street.
- 6. Maxi-taxis plying for hire shall park as follows:

Maxi-taxi stands

- (a) a maximum of sixteen maxi-taxis operating the Port-of-Spain/Petit Valley route shall stand for hire facing north on the western side of Charlotte Street, from a point thirty-five metres south of its intersection with Park Street; and
- (b) a maximum of ten maxi-taxis operating the Port-of-Spain/Maraval route shall stand for hire facing west on the southern side of Duke Street, between Henry Street and Charlotte Street.
- 7. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these offence and Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence to a fine penalty of seven hundred and fifty dollars, and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars.
- 8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding of vehicles contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and unlawfully impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the parked Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
