MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 9) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 9) Order, 2011.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Mr. Simon David Hughes, QC	Of the Honourable Society of Gray's Inn: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in November, 1995 and appointed Queen's Counsel in 2011.

PART II

Mr. Simon David Hughes, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following matters and any other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the matters, namely:

Civil Appeal No. 48 of 2011—H.C.A. No. 3400 of 1999—National Stadium Project (Grenada) Corporation and NH International (Caribbean) Limited and Clico Investment Bank Limited, ICS (Grenada) Limited; and
