MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Steelband Panorama) Order, 2011. Citation

2. This Order shall have effect on the following times and dates: Duration

- (a) from 7.00 a.m. on Sunday 20th February, 2011 to 2.00 a.m. on Monday 21st February, 2011; and
- (b) from 5.00 p.m. on Saturday 5th March, 2011 to 4.00 a.m. on Sunday 6th March, 2011.

3. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Cipriani Boulevard;
- (b) Chancery Lane;
- (c) Albion Street, between Victoria Avenue and Chancery Lane;
- (d) Pembroke Street, between Keate Street and Gordon Street;
- (e) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Gordon Street;
- (f) Keate Street;
- (g) Queen's Park East, between Jerningham Avenue and Queen's Park West;
- (h) Charlotte Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street;
- (i) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;
- (j) Victoria Avenue, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street, except for taxis at the Queen's Park Taxi Stand;
- (k) Dundonald Street, between Melville Lane and Queen's Park West;

Parking
prohibited

(l) Stanmore Avenue, between Queen's Park West and Tranquillity Street;

(m) Victoria Avenue, between Albion Street and Tragarete Road; and

(n) Dere Street, between Cummins Lane and Melville Lane.

Parking permitted

4. Parking is permitted on the eastern side of Dundonald Street, south of Melville Lane, for the Public Transport Service Corporation buses.

One-way traffic

5. Vehicular traffic shall only proceed in a westerly direction along Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street.

Roads closed

6. (1) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

(a) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;

(b) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Cipriani Boulevard;

(c) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane; and

(d) Chancery Lane, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West, except for vehicles conveying steelband instruments.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1)(b), vehicles conveying steelband instruments are permitted along Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Cipriani Boulevard.

Parking in Queen's Park Savannah

7. Vehicles may use the entrances at White Hall, Casual's Corner and St. Ann's Roundabout in accordance with the directions of Police Officers on duty to park in the Queen's Park Savannah.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
