THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2011

ORDER

Made by the President under Regulation 3(1) of the Emergency Powers Regulations

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (SEIZURE OF PROPERTY) ORDER, 2011

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Seizure of Citation Property) Order, 2011.
- 2. In this Order, "scrap metal" means discarded metal suitable for Definition reprocessing.
- 3. (1) For the purpose of dealing with the circumstances of any Sequestration situation arising or existing during the period of public emergency, the Commissioner of Police or the Chief of Defence Staff may seize and take possession of any scrap metal stored in Trinidad and Tobago.
- (2) Where scrap metal is taken possession of under subparagraph (1) it may be dealt with in any manner considered necessary during the period of public emergency.
- 4. Adequate compensation for the taking of possession shall be paid Compensation to the owner of the scrap metal and, in default of agreement, the Court may determine, upon the application of the owner or any person claiming to be the owner of the scrap metal, the amount and manner of payment of compensation in relation to the claimant including where necessary any question of his entitlement to compensation.
