THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 11) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for ^{Citation} Admission) (No. 11) Order, 2011.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a ^{Eligibility for} Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales ^{admission to} for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law ^{practise} in Trinidad and Tobago, subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.
