UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 13) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for ^{Citation} Admission) (No. 13) Order, 2011.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a ^{Eligibility for} Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales ^{admission to} for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law ^{practise} in Trinidad and Tobago, subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

PART II

Mr. David Huw Williams, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause, namely:

The Commission of Enquiry into the failure of C.L. Financial Limited and Others and Hindu Credit Union Co-operative Society Limited.
