MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE  
MINISTER UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND  
ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (MAXI-  
TAXI STAND/MAXI-TAXI STOP) (CUREPE/SAN JUAN)  
REGULATIONS, 2011

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control<sup>Citation</sup>  
(Experimental Scheme) (Maxi-Taxi Stand/Maxi-Taxi Stop) (Curepe/  
San Juan) Regulations, 2011.
2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday<sup>Duration</sup>  
21st November, 2011 to Sunday 19th February, 2012.
3. In these Regulations, “maxi-taxi” means a public service vehicle<sup>Interpretation</sup>  
with seating accommodation for not less than nine nor more than  
twenty-five passengers.
4. These Regulations apply to a maxi-taxi authorized by the<sup>Application of</sup>  
Minister to operate on the Priority Bus Route. Regulations
5. A maximum of ten maxi-taxis operating the westbound route<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup>  
shall park facing west on the southern side of the Priority Bus Route,<sup>stand</sup>  
nine metres west of the Southern Main Road. Curepe
6. A maxi-taxi stop for westbound maxi-taxis operating the<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup>  
westbound route shall be marked on the southern side of the Priority<sup>stop</sup>  
Bus Route, nine metres east of the Southern Main Road. Curepe
7. A maximum of eight maxi-taxis operating the eastbound route<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup>  
shall park facing east on the northern side of the Priority Bus Route<sup>stand</sup>  
from a point nine metres west of Saddle Road and extending to a point<sup>San Juan</sup>  
twenty-one metres westward.
8. A maxi-taxi stop for eastbound maxi-taxis operating the<sup>Maxi-taxi</sup>  
eastbound route shall be marked on the northern side of the Priority<sup>stop</sup>  
Bus Route from a point twenty-two metres west of Saddle Road and<sup>San Juan</sup>  
extending to a point thirty-five metres westward.

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No stopping alongside another maxi-taxi      9. A maxi-taxi shall not stop alongside another maxi-taxi at any designated stop or stand.

Offence and penalty      10. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked      11. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
