A PROCLAMATION

Whereas section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides *inter alia*, that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace or other emergency requiring such service occurs, or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress, or to prevent, or deal with:

And whereas the State deems it necessary to call out to duty, members of the Volunteer Defence Force for a period of thirty-one days with effect from March 1, 2011 to March 31, 2011 to serve as a reserve corps to assist the civil authority in providing security support for Carnival 2011:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, hereby call out for a period of thirty-one days with effect from March 1, 2011, to March 31, 2011, a complement of ten officers and two hundred and forty other ranks of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in the maintenance of peace and public order in Trinidad and Tobago.
