## REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Transport under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffice Act

## THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (MARACAS/St. JOSEPH) REGULATIONS, 2011

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (experimental Scheme) (Maracas/St. Joseph) Regulations, 2011.
- 2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 28th March, 2011 <sup>Duration</sup> and shall expire on Sunday 26th June, 2011.
  - 3. Motorists shall proceed in—

One-way

- (a) a westerly direction on McLean Street, between Piccadilly Street and Narine Trace, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays;
- (b) a westerly direction on King Street, between Piccadilly Street and Abercromby Street, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays;
- (c) a northerly direction on Piccadilly Street, between King Street and Richmond Street, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays;
- (d) a southerly direction on Piccadilly Street, between King Street and Richmond Street, between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays;
- (e) an easterly direction on McLean Street, between Piccadilly Street and Narine Trace, between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays; and
- (f) an easterly direction on King Street, between Piccadilly Street and Abercromby Street, between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays.

No entry

4. Motorists are prohibited from entering the Eastern Main Road from Queen Street, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays.

Parking prohibited 5. Motorists shall not park along Abercromby Street, between the Eastern Main Road and Riverside Road.

Offence and penalty

6. Any person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffice Act.
