Made by the President under section 5(1) of the Land Acquisition Act

THE LAND ACQUISITION (REQUISITION) ORDER, 2011

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Requisition) Citation Order, 2011.
- 2. Three parcels of land together comprising 792.6 square metres Land more or less, situate off the western side of the Uriah Butler Highway required Reserve, north of Cemetery Street, south of Road No. 2 (Maraj Street), purpose and east of Road No. 6, Warner Village, Charlieville, in the Ward of Cunupia, in the County of Caroni and described in the Schedule and coloured raw sienna on a plan of survey signed by the Director of Surveys and dated 30th July, 1997 and filed in his office, are required for a public purpose: the improvement of the dual carriageway of the Uriah Butler Highway.

SCHEDULE

Three parcels of land comprising 792.6 square metres more or less, situate off the western side of the Uriah Butler Highway Reserve, north of Cemetery Street, south of Road No. 2, (Maraj Street), and east of Road No. 6, Warner Village, Charlieville, in the Ward of Cunupia, in the County of Caroni and said to belong now or formerly to Basi Gildharie and further described as follows:

- (a) a parcel of land comprising 271.4 square metres known as Lot No. 1;
- (b) a parcel of land comprising 258.9 square metres known as Lot No. 2; and
- (c) a parcel of land comprising 262.3 square metres known as Lot No. 3.
