THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (SINGLE PAN BANDS PRELIMINARY) ORDER, 2011

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Single Pan Bands Preliminary) Order, 2011.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation at 5.00 p.m. on Saturday Duration 5th February, 2011 and shall cease at 2.00 a.m. on Sunday 6th February, 2011.
 - 3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on—

Roads closed

- (a) Ariapita Avenue, between Colville Street and Flament and parking Street; and
- (b) Park Street, between Flament Street and Richmond Street.
- 4. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking

- (a) Colville Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road; and
- (b) Richmond Street, between Park Street and Independence Square North.
- 5. Notwithstanding regulation 4, vehicles conveying steel pans may Parking park on Richmond Street and Ariapita Avenue.
- 6. All Bands shall assemble on Ariapita Avenue, between Flament Band route Street and Colville Street, then proceed east along Ariapita Avenue onto Park Street for judging at Victoria Square.
- 7. On completion of their performance, bands shall continue east $_{Disassem}$ along Park Street and disassemble at the intersection of Park and bling Richmond Streets.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
