AN ACT to supplement and vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of which was authorized by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2013.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of one thousand, five hundred and sixty-eight million, one hundred and sixty-six thousand, seven hundred and twenty-five dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2012 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.

3. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

5. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011 and not utilized at the commencement of this Act may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
