The Bill seeks to provide for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending September 30, 2014 by authorizing the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of fifty-six thousand, four hundred and forty-one million, thirty-six thousand, three hundred and twenty dollars (\$56,441,036,320).

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Short title (Financial Year 2014) Act, 2013.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized

Schedule

2. (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of fifty-six thousand, four hundred and forty-one million, thirty-six thousand, three hundred and twenty dollars (\$56,441,036,320) is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2014, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule.

(2) The sum specified in the Second Column of the Schedule, in relation to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule, is appropriated out of the sum of fifty-six thousand, four hundred and forty-one million, thirty-six thousand, three hundred and twenty dollars (\$56,441,036,320) for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2014.

Commencement

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2013.
