NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE WHICH REQUIRES AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT SUBMITTED BY NIKO RESOURCES (BLOCK 4B CARIBBEAN) LIMITED

Notice is hereby given that Niko Resources (Block 4B Caribbean) Limited ("Niko") is desirous of drilling up to four (4) exploration wells to establish the presence of hydrocarbons within Block 4(b) off the east coast of Trinidad, and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order (as amended), thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, Chap. 35:05 ("the Act"). Niko has applied for a Certificate of Environmental Clearance ("the Certificate") from the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority") for this project.
