MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (CUREPE) ORDER, 2013

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Curepe) Citation Order, 2013.
- 2. Maxi-taxis that ply the Curepe to Chaguanas route shall not No entry to enter—
 - (a) the Southern Main Road, between the Eastern Main Road and Havelock Street;
 - (b) Broome Street, between Havelock Street and Evans Street;
 - (c) Market Street, between Havelock Street and Evans Street;
 - (d) Phillip Street, between the Southern Main Road and Mc Donald Street;
 - (e) Clifford Street, between the Southern Main Road and Mc Donald Street;
 - (f) Mc Donald Street, between Phillip Street and Evans Street; and
 - (g) Evans Street (east), between Clifford Street and Harris Street.
- 3. Taxi drivers may not ply for hire their taxis or maxi-taxis on No plying for Broome Street, between Fowler Street and Havelock Street.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order $^{\text{offence and}}$ is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three thousand dollars or to $^{\text{penalty}}$ imprisonment for three months.
- 5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and of vehicles impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the parked Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
