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APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE (*Customs Act, Chap. 78:01*)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Ammar Samaroo, Acting Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereunder to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods, as shall be warehoused by or in the Private Warehouse of Messrs. Sterling Service (Battoo Bros.) Limited, No. 70 Sackville Street, Port-of-Spain—Vans, Pick-ups, Trucks, Cars and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.

SCHEDULE

A rectangular area measuring 16 metres by 38.5 metres comprising 616 square metres enclosed by a concrete wall to a height of 3 metres to the north, a chain linked fence to a height of 2.1 metres with a 1.8 metre wide gate to the south, a concrete wall to a height of 2 metres with a 5 metre wide wrought iron gate to the east and partially by a concrete wall to a height of 4 metres and a chain linked fence to a height of 2.1 metres to the west. The aforesaid area is uncovered on the east and covered by a galvanised roof supported by eight steel beams to a height of 4.9 metres to the west containing an enclosed area measuring 10.08 metres by 11.8 metres comprising 119 metres enclosed by concrete and ventilation block walls to north, south east and west with a 1.8 metre wide gate to the west and covered with B.R.C wire mesh.
