THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CHAP. 48:50

REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Infrastructure under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (DUKE STREET, PORT-OF-SPAIN) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2014

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (Duke Street, Port-of-Spain) (No. 2) Regulations, 2014.
- 2. These Regulations shall commence on Tuesday 26th August, Duration 2014 and expire on Monday 24th November, 2014.
- 3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the southern No parking side of Duke Street, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street, from a point nine metres west of St. Vincent Street and extending to a point forty-nine metres westward, as marked, Monday to Friday except for persons driving official motor vehicles of the Maritime Services Division, Ministry of Transport.
- 4. Any person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on Offence and summary conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and penalty fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.
- 5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and of vehicles impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the parked Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
